

CLINICAL LABORATORY SCIENCES PROGRAM NATIONAL BOARD EXAM STATISTICS

Of the 50 students who have taken the ASCP Board of Registry National Certification Exam from 2003 through April 2008, 47 students (94%) passed the exam on the first attempt, two of the three initial failures passed on the second attempt for an overall 98% pass rate.

However if you review the first 3 years since our last accreditation cycle (2003-2005) versus the past two (2006-April 2008) there is significant improvement in our overall exam statistics. The first time pass rate for 2003-2005 is 89% with 97% overall pass rate. The pass rate for 2006 – through April 2008 has been 100% on the first attempt with no failures.
